Pastor's Letter

Discipleship Shouldn't Be Lonely

As we enter a new year of Christian education, we are also engaging the last half of our season of yearly growth during "ordinary time." This is the time after Pentecost, when we read in Acts of the Apostles how they were sent by Christ to share his gospel in Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria and to the ends of the earth. I truly believe we are to continue this mission because Jesus prayed for such unity in him and therefore God the Father, too, at least according to John's gospel. So we are to teach as we grow, inviting others to know Jesus who has already authored their lives and wants them to understand how much he loves them and wants to redeem them from the world for everlasting life in him to the glory of God.

This is the work we are to do as Christians, and we have a unique context in which to do it as members of the North American Lutheran Church in Monroeville, Ohio. Church Council Updates

Church Council Minutes August 13, 2025

Present: Pastor Dan, Gary Underwood, Ken Underwood, Rob Ludwig, Missy Kluding, Jeff

Little, Cindy Schuller, Dan Smith Absent: Lorie Pierce, Jennifer Miller

<u>Devotions & Prayer:</u> Pastor Dan opened with prayer. Devotions on Luke 10:1-20 were done at the end of the meeting.

<u>Treasurers Report and Minutes:</u> The treasurers report for July was reviewed and discussed. A question on discrepancies with the amount of collections given to the Love Bus was discussed. It was determined that the total amounts collected and donated were accurate.

Minutes from the July meeting were reviewed.

Rob made a motion to accept both reports. Dan seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- 1) Pastor Dan was asked about progress on completing and distributing our photo directory. He reported that he is updating the church history page. He would like to add some photos of ministry and mission activities. There are still many members without photos to put in the directory. Pastor will attempt to have one last photo shoot available on Rally Day for anyone who hasn't gotten their picture taken yet. Pastor Dan committed to completing the directory by November 1, 2025.
- 2) Remodeled worship space will be dedicated during service on Rally Day.
- 3) Pastor Dan reviewed the church constitution and pointed out several typos and errors that Bruce had found when proofreading it. Council agreed that these errors did not change the content of the constitution and that it was appropriate to make corrections without requiring an additional vote. Council discussed the upcoming vote for the congregational vote to approve amendments to the constitution. Gary brought up concerns about some of the language in the existing constitution (ch.12.11) that required the Pastor to approve agenda items for meetings that he would not be in attendance for. He explained why that language was part of the constitution to council's satisfaction.
- 4) Gary suggested that we should consider giving \$10,000 from the investment fund to the NALC 20/20 Vision (Today, Tomorrow, and Forever) Fund. He made a motion to give that amount, Jeff 2nd his motion, and council approved it after discussion.

 *A special meeting was held after worship on 8/17/25 to withdraw this vote and replaced it with a motion to recommend to the congregation that we give \$10,000 to NALC 20/20 Vision Fund after a congregational vote in 3 weeks. The motion carried.

Property and Planning Team:

1) Pastor Dan reported that the old refrigerator died and needs to be removed from the kitchen. Cindy said that she would call a contact who recycles metals and see if they



would remove it.

2) Jeff reported that he had a discussion with the neighbor behind the church about the old lilac bush that splits our property and is full of poison ivy. She agreed that it would be good to kill and remove the lilac and weeds. Jeff will use Round-Up on it next week and remove it in the fall.

<u>Mission Team:</u> Gary talked to Lori Griffith about coordinating with her to plan this years Journey to Bethlehem. She is looking forward to receiving the help.

Worship Team: Reporting: Pastor Dan

- 1) Charlene Henney's memorial service will be held on Friday, 8/15/25 at 5:00PM. Becky Schultz from Mansfield will play the organ.
- 2) Missy brought up a concern that was discussed in the past about having a team to look for and assist families in our church who may need visitors or assistance of some kind. Pastor Dan said that he would invite people to serve on the gifts team to fill this roll.

Christian Education Team: Reporting: Missy

74 children attended Bible School. Everyone's help in making it successful was appreciated. The Love Bus was the recipient of nearly \$500 collected during VBS.

Parish Life Team: No Report

<u>Pastor's Report:</u> Pastor Dan reported that he will be using a structured program to teach catechism this year and will work with another adult to teach it.

Pastor Dan will be visiting family on 9/31/25 and will use a supply pastor to preside over worship. Monica will preside over worship on 9/7/25 when Pastor Dan will be serving the NALC church in Port Clinton.

<u>Gifts Team:</u> No Report, mentioned in worship Team discussion

<u>New Business</u>: Jeff asked about adopting a new mission statement. Pastor wants to bring someone in for a council retreat to lead us in vision planning during a retreat.
