# Church Council Updates Church Council Minutes

October 8, 2025

<u>Present:</u> Pastor Dan, Ken Underwood, Rob Ludwig, Gary Underwood, Jeff Little, Dan Smith, Lorie Pierce, Bruce Kinsel

<u>Absent:</u> Jennifer Miller, Missy Kluding, Cindy Schuller

**Devotions & Prayer:** Pastor Dan opened with prayer. Devotions on Acts 16:6-16

Treasurer's Report and Minutes:

Bruce presented an update on our investment account. After giving \$10,000 to the NALC 20/20 vision Initiative, there is a current balance of \$91,574 in the account. Bruce suggests that we maintain a value of at least \$100,000 so that earnings will accrue at a rate that we will be able to use them to support future mission work.

The treasurer's report was not reviewed. Sharon is moving out of town and will not be serving as our treasurer. Pastor Dan is continuing to look for someone to serve as our treasurer. Minutes from last month were reviewed and accepted as written.

Pastor Dan moved to accept the minutes, Rob seconded, motion carried.

## Old Business:

1) Pastor Dan reported that completing the photo-directory is his focus for the next few weeks and he hopes to have it completed before the start of November.

2) Gifts Team - Pastor Dan reported that after giving it much thought he doesn't believe we need a "gifts team." He has identified Angie Swanbeck as a coordinator to make sure people who are connected to TLC and need assistance are looked after.

3) 2 students will be confirmed at the end of October.

**Property and Planning Team:** 

1) Ken presented an outline for a 5-year plan to budget for maintaining our building and grounds. He is seeking more feedback before presenting it to the congregation.

## **Mission Team:**

1) Lorie Pierce is seeking donations for snacks to deliver to the teachers at school.

2) Pastor Dan reminded council that if we need to upgrade or replace any of the settings or supplies needed for the Journey to Bethlehem that there is money granted for that purpose through the 21st Century Fund.

3) Gary reports that Lori Griffith is preparing to find people and pass out parts for the Journey to Bethlehem.

Worship Team: Reporting: Pastor Dan

1) Choir will be singing at services the 2nd Sunday of each month. In order to support the choir we should include a line in the next budget to pay the keyboardist \$910 for travel and \$200 - \$300 for music; \$1200 total.

2) Pastor Dan reports that we will have Advent services at 7:00.

3) Christmas Eve service will be at 7:00. The Nufers have offered use of their barn as a venue for a later 2nd service.



- 4) Pastor will be buying tapered bee's wax candles to use for All Saints Day and Christmas. They will be easier to light and do not drip as much as the candles we have been using.
- 5) Sharon Heyman's recognition and send-off will be this Sunday, 10/12/25.

<u>Christian Education Team:</u> Missy Kluding's written report

- 1) After a successful Rally Day our students will be learning stories from the Old Testament this Fall. After Christmas the focus will be on the New Testament.
- 2) Punch cards will be used this year to encourage, record, and award attendance.
- 3) There will be a sock collection for the month of October as focus for offering and giving.
- 4) Invite a friend to Sunday School Welcome bags will be handed out to new guests at Sunday School.
- 5) We're exploring the idea of starting a Young Adult group during Sunday School for anyone in high school their 20's. Stay tuned for more details.
- 6) Youth Club restarted with about 30 kids attending!
- 7) Planning has begun for this year's Christmas Program.




